

PUBLIC NOTICE

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL TRAFFIC CALMING

BROADBRIDGE HEATH

As part of the current WSCC IWP programme of works we will shortly be undertaking improvement works to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds through the village of Broadbridge Heath. The proposed works are intended to provide a safer environment for local residents by reducing vehicle speeds and will involve:

Phase 1 – 20mph Speed Limit:

- Implementation of a village 20mph speed limit throughout the village facilitated by the new traffic regulation order and associated signing and lining works.
- New vehicle activated warning signs to be erected on Billingshurst Road north of the junction with Pinewood Close; and on Old Guildford Road south of the junction with Mulberry Gardens

Works to commence from **Monday 2nd October for 2 weeks** (subject to favourable weather conditions) and in order to protect the public and our workforce the works will be carried out between the hours of 07:00 to 19:00hrs with temporary traffic management. No road closures will be required for this phase of works.

Phase 2 – Traffic calming features and environmental improvements:

- New mini roundabout on Billingshurst Road at the junction with Shelley Drive.
- Village Centre improvements, adjacent to the post office
- Billingshurst Road/Old Guildford Road, advisory cycle lanes and centreline removal.
- Sleets Road mini roundabout improvements

Works commencement date to be confirmed and I will write to you again once I have the details. Advance warning signs will be erected in the local area to inform road users of the proposed works.
