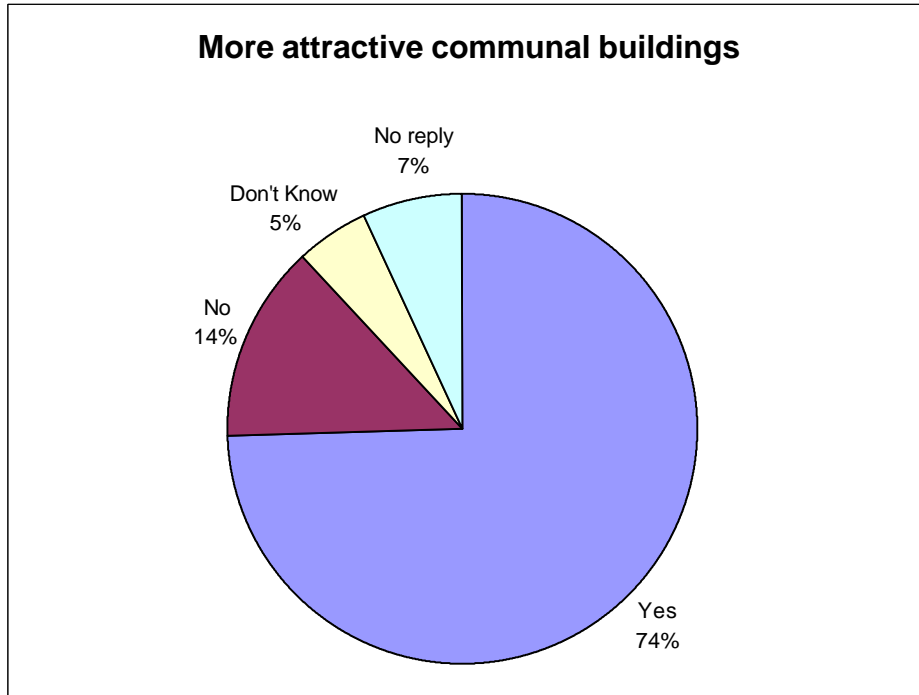

1) In general, could communal buildings such as the Village Centre, Church Hall, Scout Hut and car parks be made more attractive through landscaping, planting or better signs.



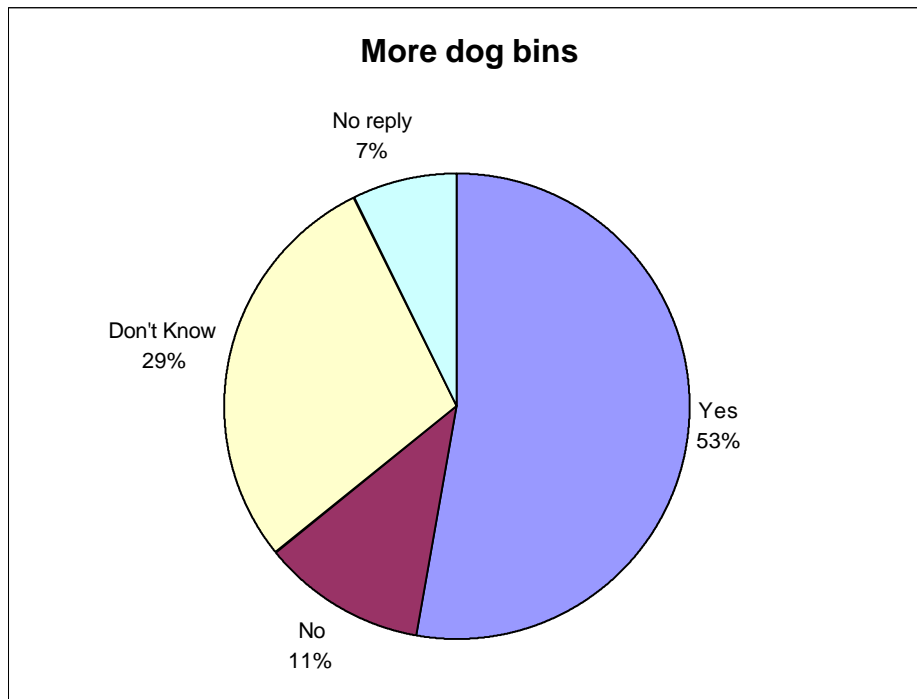

12) Does your current housing meet your present / future needs?



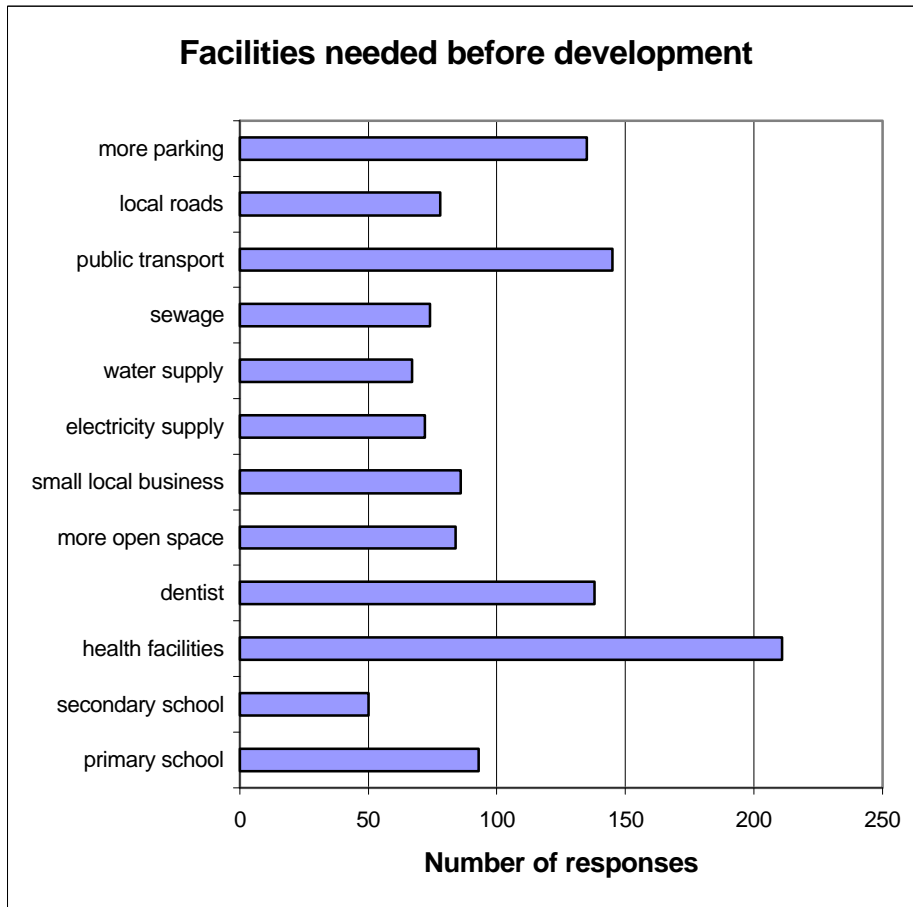
13) If significant development should occur around Broadbridge Heath, what type of housing should be built to meet the future needs of the present village population?

21) How frequently do you use the local bus services?



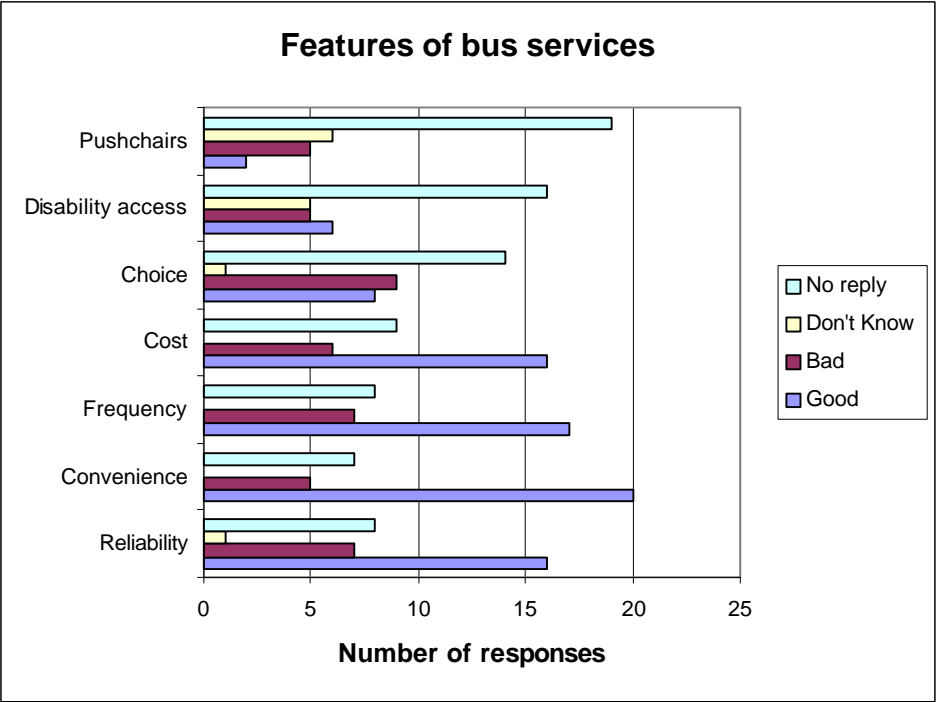
When do you use the bus service?

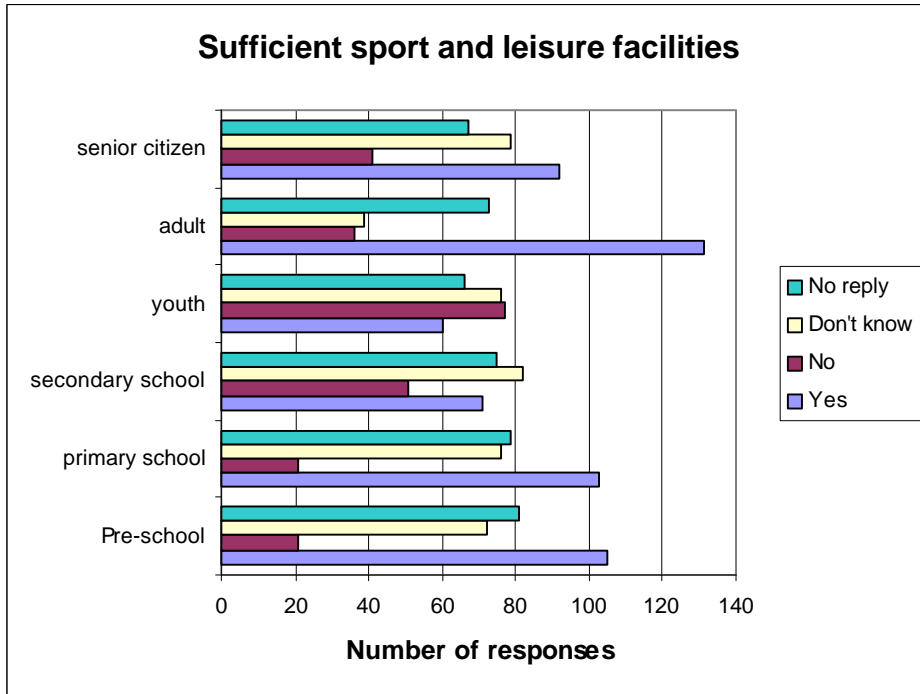

22) If you do use the bus service, how do you rate it for the following features?

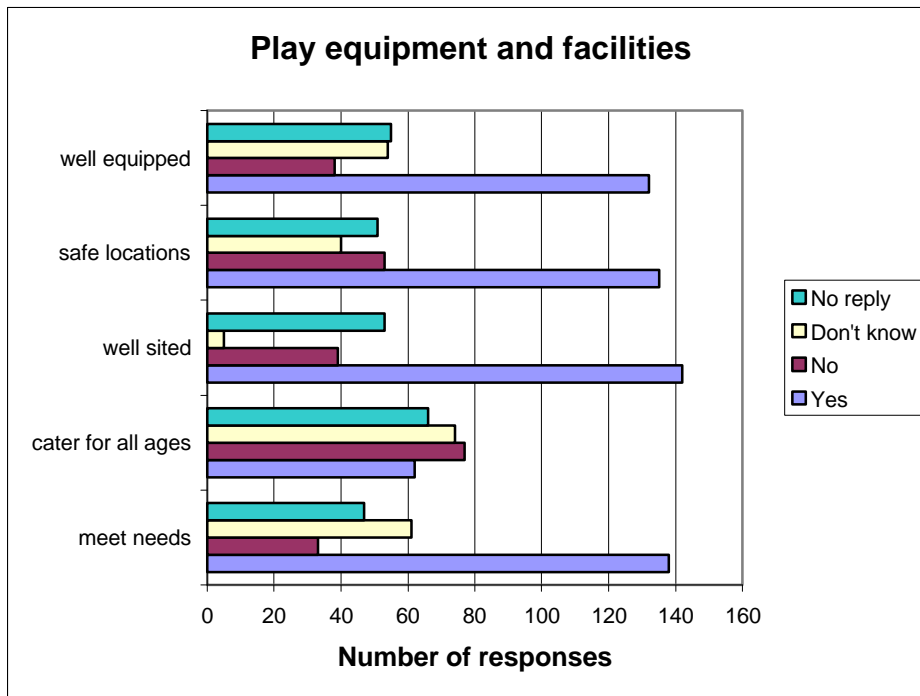

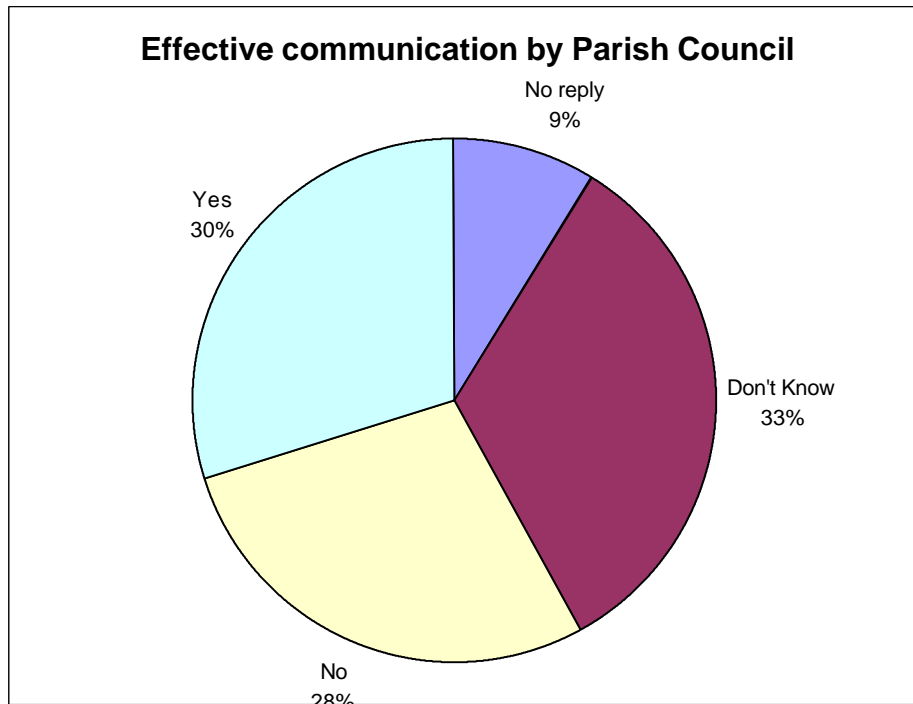
29) If broadband Internet access was made available throughout the village, would you use it?



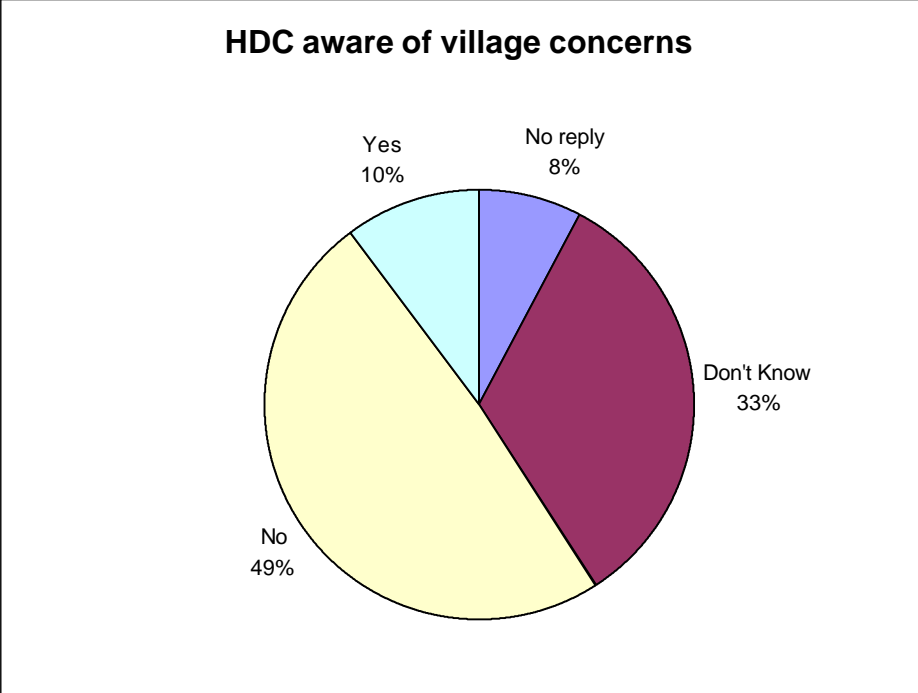

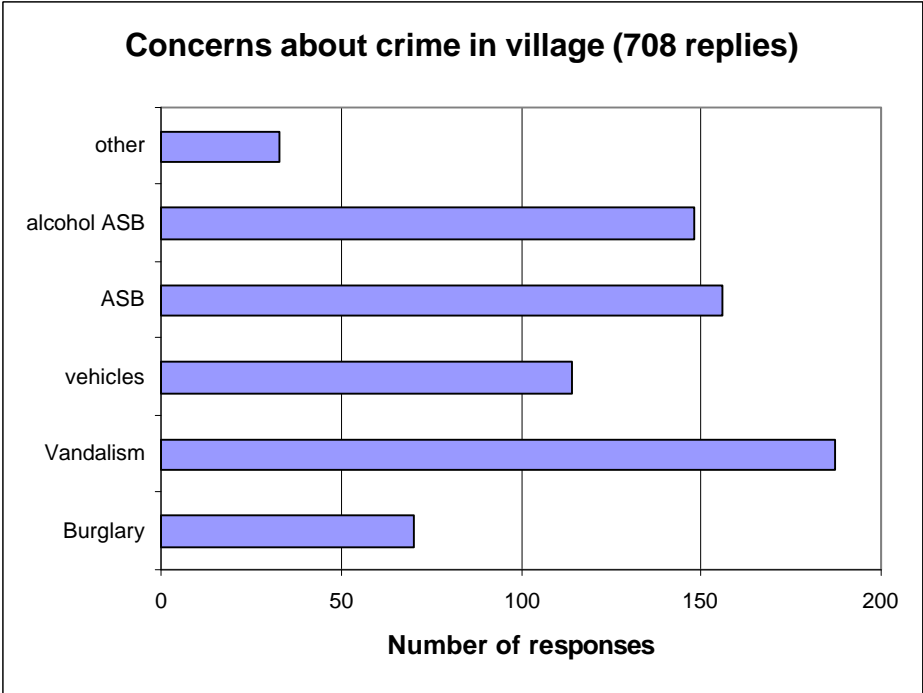


Do you think Horsham District Council represents village people well and is aware of local concerns?

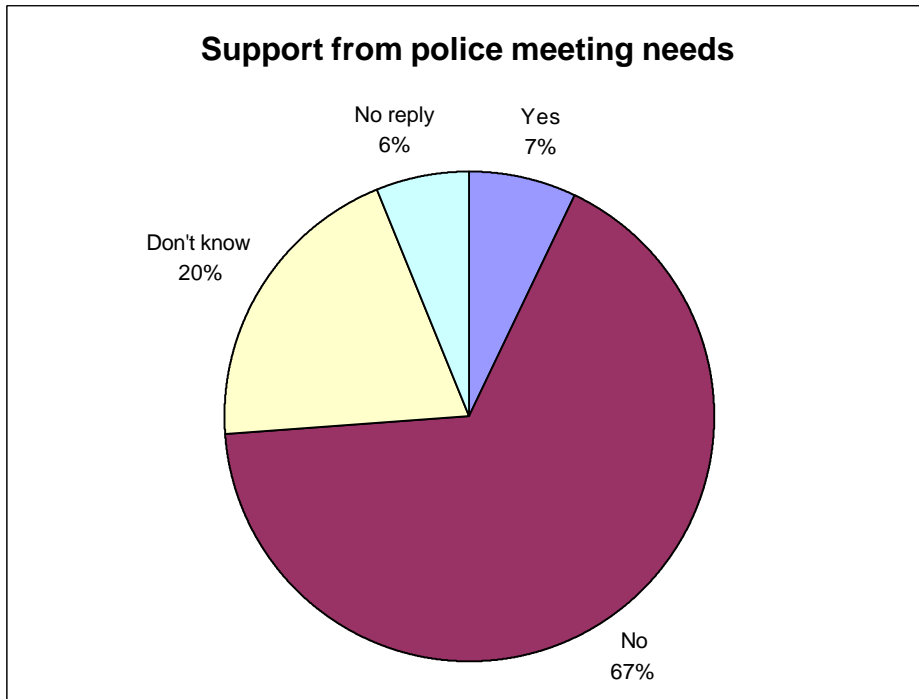

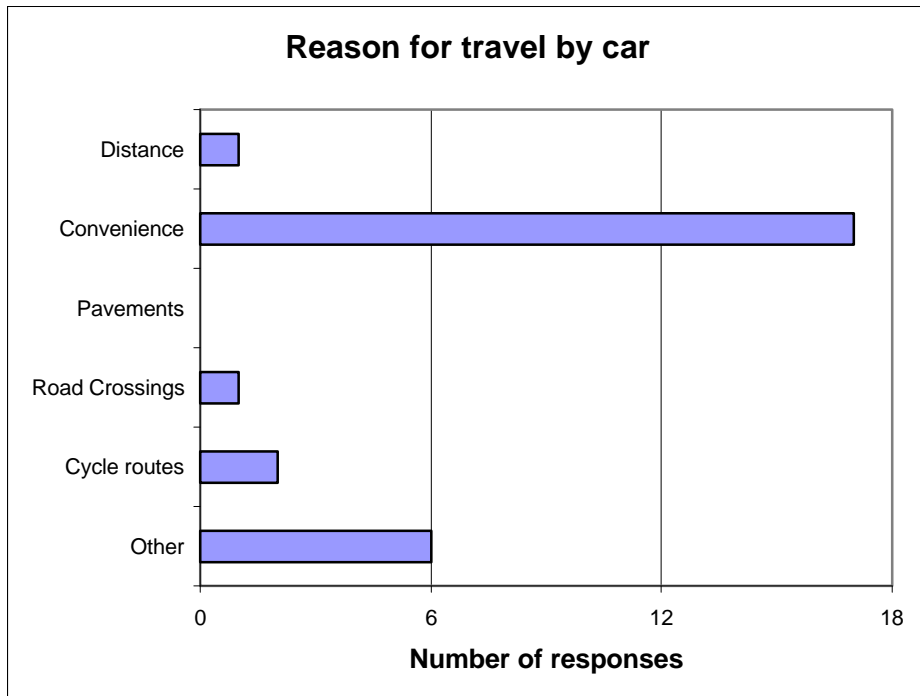

37) How do your children travel to school?



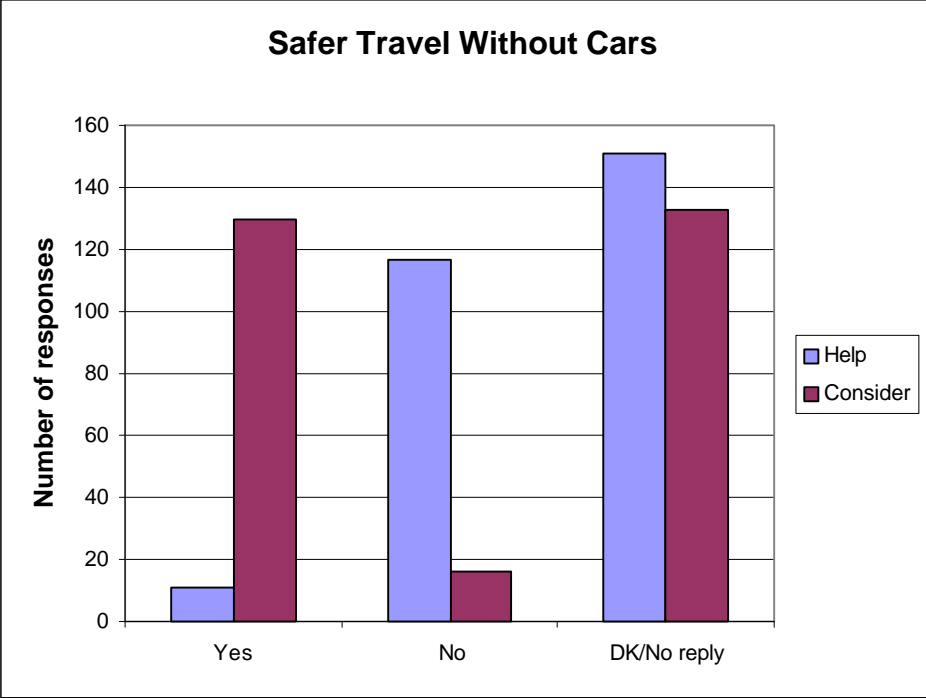

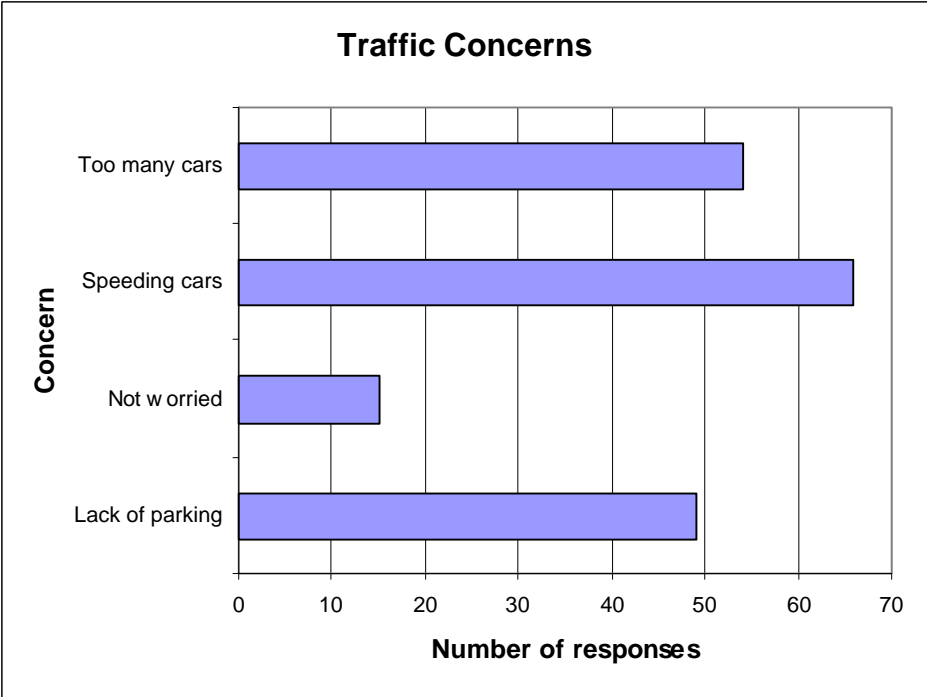
4) Is the wildlife and nature in B.B.H. important to you?



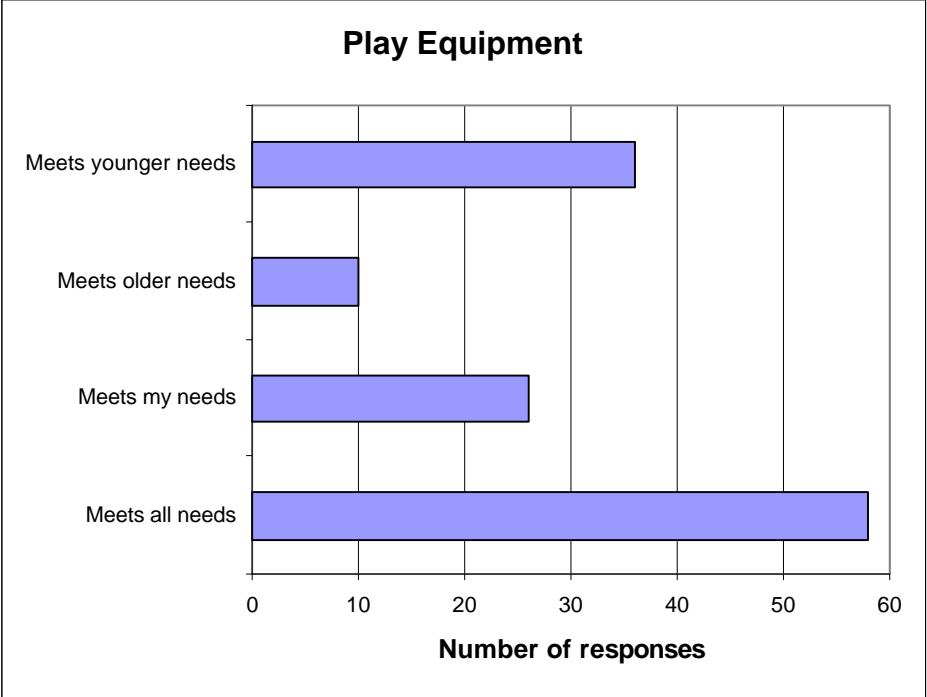

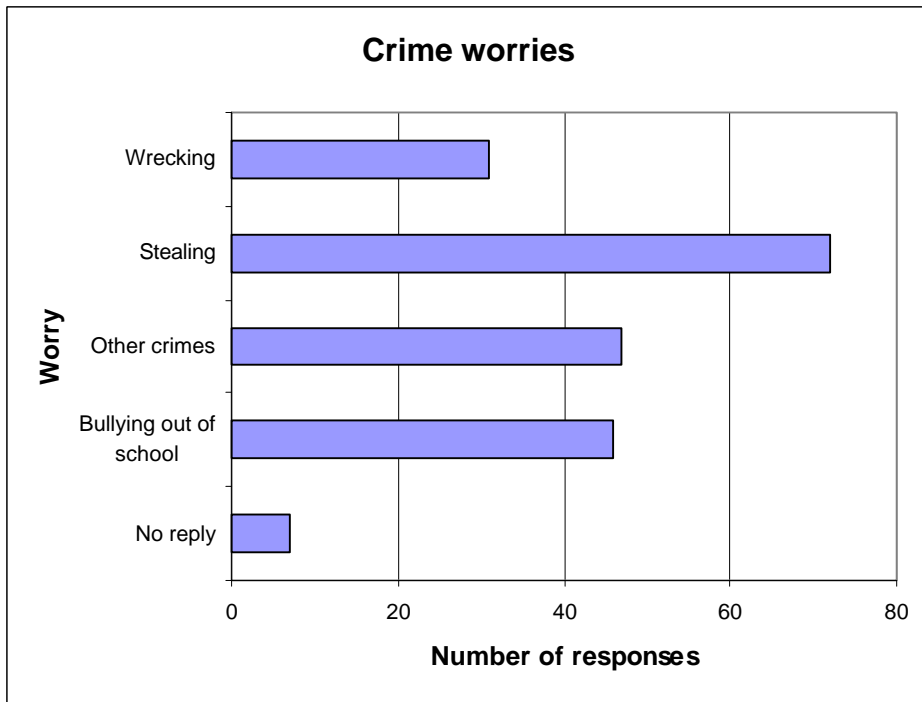
Age groups who found the equipment meets their needs.



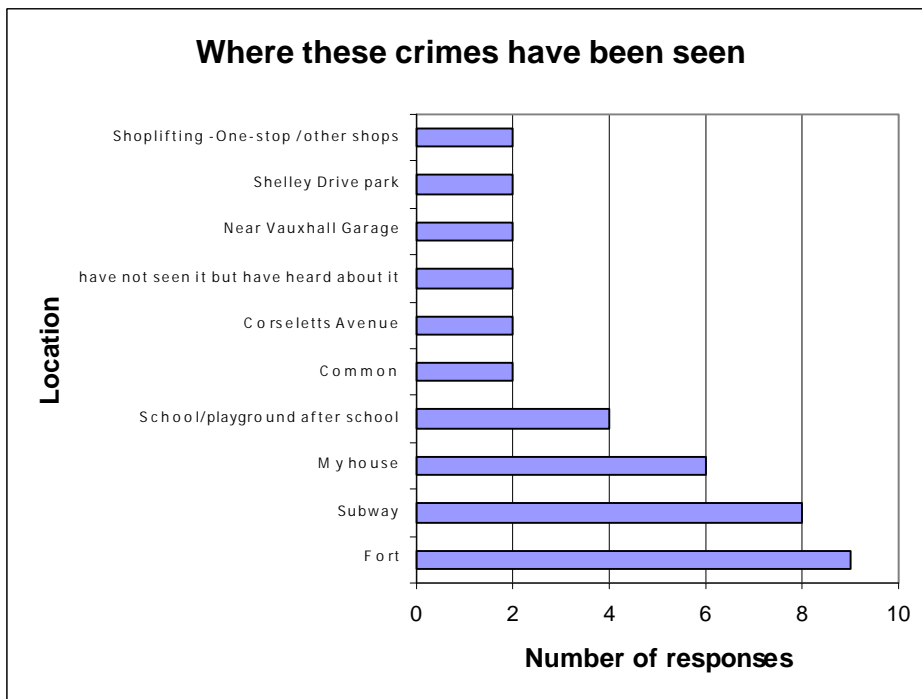
Age groups who felt the equipment meets younger needs.



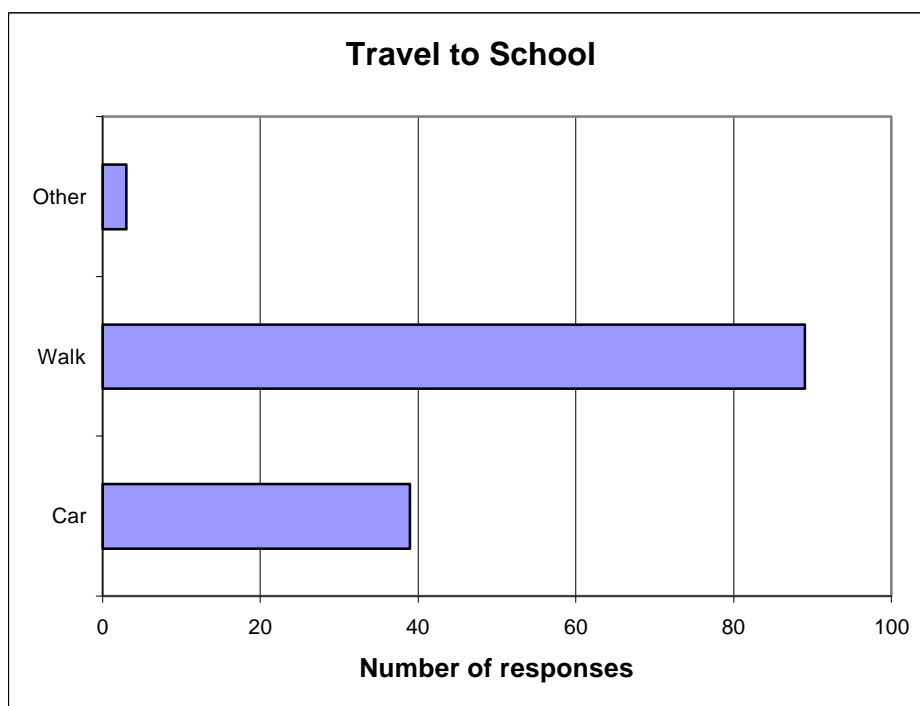
