Temporary closure of A24 Entry Slip Road Southbound & A24 Exit Slip Road Northbound, Broadbridge Heath, 31st March 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic A24 Entry Slip Road Southbound and A24 Exit Slip Road Northbound, Broadbridge Heath, in the Horsham District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on A24 Entry Slip Road Southbound and A24 Exit Slip Road Northbound for a distance approx 404.00 metres.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 31st March 2021 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 1st April 2021) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Jacksons Civil Engineering undertakes WSCC improvement works - installation of signs - only one slip lane to be closed at a time - contact is

The restriction will be in place **day-time only** from 08:00 until 17:30

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
