WATER SHORTAGES FOR PARISHES AND RESIDENTS

Where areas of Sussex have been affected by long periods of water shortages. e.g. up to a week, preparation for any future water shortages should be considered.

There are:

Collection points to be set up by a forum for bottled water to be provided.

- Consider the number of residents who will access these collection points.
- Most people will arrive by car. Long queues will cause delay of not only the residents collecting but also delivery lorries providing more water.
- Where will these collection points be situated?
- Is the road easily accessible without having police support?
- Where will the locations be?

Are there wells and bore holes within your Parish? (Private Water Supply). Can they be used? Has the Parish or Town Council considered keeping these active and clean so they can be used during periods when they are needed?

4 litres (7 pints) of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation.

Access to water butts and vessels of water that are outside for flushing toilets.

Kettle to boil water

Water purification tablets.

Wet Wipes for personal hygiene
