



# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Temporary closure of A24 Exit Slip Road Northbound, Broadbridge Heath , 15th February 2021

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic A24 Exit Slip Road Northbound, Broadbridge Heath CP, in the Horsham District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on A24 Exit Slip Road Northbound between the Tesco Service Road and Farthings Hill Roundabout for a distance approx 226.00 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 15th February 2021 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 17th February 2021) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Landbuild on behalf of West Sussex County Council undertakes the Upgrading to VRS systems on approach to Farthings Hill Interchange. Closed from junction with the Horsham Bypass to junction with Farthings Hill Roundabout.

The restriction will be in place **overnight only** from 19:00 until 06:00

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
